

Order No. 18/2019

of the Director of the Institute of Geophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences,

of 1 December 2019

**regarding the appointment of the International Advisory Board at the Institute
of Geophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences**

Pursuant to § 10(3)(1), § 11(1)(5), § 11(1)(6) and § 12 of the Statutes of the Institute of Geophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences, adopted by the Scientific Council of the Institute of Geophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences, on 24 February 2011, approved by the President of the Polish Academy of Sciences on 9 May 2011, amended by the resolution of the Scientific Council of the Institute of Geophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences, of 23 October 2012, approved by the President of the Polish Academy of Sciences on 18 December 2012, and by the resolution of the Scientific Council of the Institute of Geophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences, of 12 February 2014, approved by the President of the Polish Academy of Sciences on 24 September 2014, amended by the resolution of the Scientific Council of the Institute of Geophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences, of 15 June 2016, approved by the President of the Polish Academy of Sciences on 18 November 2016, amended by the resolution of the Scientific Council of the Institute of Geophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences, of 23 February 2017, approved by the President of the Polish Academy of Sciences on 20 March 2017, amended by the resolution of the Scientific Council of the Institute of Geophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences, of 27 June 2018, approved by the President of the Polish Academy of Sciences on 8 August 2018, I decide as follows:

§ 1

I hereby appoint the International Advisory Board at the Institute of Geophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences. The Board shall consist of the following:

§ 2

Tasks to be performed by members of the International Advisory Board at IG PAS shall include providing the Director of the Institute with opinions on the areas of research and development conducted at the Institute, which can make it possible to accomplish the mission of IG PAS, including to set directions of development, enabling in the long run the strengthening of the scientific and research position of the Institute. Consultations shall cover the strategy and planning of research and development at the Institute, the use and dissemination of research results, cooperation with national and international institutions and education.
